

GARBAGE:

All regular household waste must be placed in the Borough issued automated collection container. The automated container shall be placed curbside by 6:30 a.m. on your designated garbage pick-up day. The automated container shall be removed no later than 8:00 p.m. the day of collection.

AUTOMATED COLLECTION CONTAINER:

All household waste shall be bagged when placed in the container. The collection container must have a 4 foot clearance around it, in order to be properly emptied. The collection container is the property of the Borough of Tuckerton and must be maintained by each homeowner as if it were their own. If the container is damaged in any way, other than by the Public Works Department it will be the homeowner's responsibility to purchase a replacement from the Borough.

GARBAGE CONTAINERS SHOULD:

- Not be placed curbside prior to 24 hours before your scheduled pick-up and container shall be removed by 8:00 p.m. the day of collection.
- Not contain any recyclable material.
- Not contain hazardous materials such as, but not limited to paint, pesticides, motor oil, antifreeze, fluorescent tubes, weed killer, propane tanks, etc. Please contact the Public Works Dept. for a hazardous waste drop off schedule.
- Not contain anything other than household waste.

BRUSH/SHRUBS/WOOD/CARPET:

- Larger than 3" in diameter must be disposed of by the homeowner. The Public Works Dept. will not collect logs, stumps, tree trunks, etc.
- Must be tied in bundles not to exceed 4 ft. in length and 40 lbs. in weight.
- Carpet must be rolled up-rolls shall not exceed 4 ft. in length and 40 lbs. in weight.

BULK PICK-UP: Call 609-296-5058 to arrange pick-up of bulk items.

- A Permit is required for Air Conditioners, Refrigerators and Water Coolers

CONSTRUCTION/REMODELING/DEMOLITION DEBRIS:

- Homeowners are responsible to get a private dumpster when a permit is required as per the Uniform Construction Code Standard.
- Construction Debris that does not require a UCC permit can be brought to the Public Works Yard. There will be NO curbside pickup for these materials.

TIRES/FLUORESCENT BULBS:

- ✓ Tuckerton Public Works does NOT accept these items, please contact the Southern Ocean Recycling Center in Manahawkin at 609-978-0913 to see how you can dispose of these items with them

HOUSE CLEANOUTS:

The Public Works Dept. WILL NOT collect garbage/trash from a house cleanout. It is the homeowner's responsibility to obtain a private dumpster service for disposal of such debris.

MATERIAL TO BE RECYCLED:

PICKED UP AT CURBSIDE:

- **THE FOLLOWING SHOULD BE IN ONE CONTAINER NOT TO EXCEED 35 GALLONS – pickup based on zones**
 - ✓Newspaper
 - ✓Magazines/Junk Mail
 - ✓Paper bags
 - ✓All CLEAN paper products
 - ✓Tin/Aluminum Cans
 - ✓ALL glass bottles
 - ✓Plastic Bottles

- **CARDBOARD & RIGID PLASTIC**
 - ✓ **CARDBOARD (BUNDLED TOGETHER) – EXAMPLES ARE:**
Cereal Boxes, Non-Waxed food containers, boxes, etc.

 - ✓ **RIGID PLASTIC – EXAMPLES ARE:**
All buckets, all plastic lawn furniture, plastic totes, plastic drums, plastic toys/car seats/playhouse

NOT PICKED UP CURBSIDE – BUT CAN BE BROUGHT TO PUBLIC WORKS YARD

- T.V., Monitors and Computers
- Motor oil/cooking oil/any other oils

THINGS THAT ARE NOT RECYCLABLE MATERIAL

- Styrofoam
- Plastic bags

PLEASE NOTE: IF A HOMEOWNER'S GARBAGE IS FOUND TO CONTAIN RECYCLABLES IT WILL BE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY TO SEPARATE ALL RECYCLABLES PRIOR TO REMOVAL BY THE T.B. DPW

RECYCLABLES SHOULD:

- Be separated from regular household waste.
- Be placed curbside by 6:30 a.m. the day of collection and removed no later than 8:00 p.m. the day of collection.
- Not be placed in plastic bags.
- Be clean of all food and liquid waste.

LEAVES

Curbside leaves are collected during the whole month of April, May, October and November. Pickup will be on Tuesday throughout the months designated.

GRASS

We encourage you to cut and leave your grass clippings on your lawn when you mow, and let nature do the recycling.

“RECYCLE – IT IS THE LAW”

NJ Statewide Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act

N.J.S.A. 13:1de-99.11 et seq. (Recycling Act)

WARNINGS/FINES:

1ST Offense: Written Warning.

- a. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.
- b. Said material shall be left for the owner to properly separate.

2ND Offense: Within one (1) year of the written warning/Infraction: \$50.00 fine.

- a. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.
- b. Said materials shall be left for the owner to properly separate.
