Close the Loop, Buy Recycled!

You "close the loop" when you buy items or packaging made from recycled materials.

When you buy recycled, markets are created and a use is assured for recyclables being collected in your community and in thousands of others. Manufacturers will respond by continuing to use recyclables in their products.

Some products and packaging also have labels describing the amount of "pre-consumer" and "post-consumer" waste that was used. "Pre-consumer" waste is also known as "manufacturing waste," and includes any scraps, trimmings, over-runs, etc., from the manufacturing process. "Post-consumer" waste is a product or other material that has served its intended use and has been discarded and then collected for recycling.

Other Items Acceptable for Recycling: (Drop Off at Recycling Yard Only!)

Batteries: Household, Auto, Marine

Tires: Passenger Car & Light Trucks w/ or w/o Rims

Computers: Towers, Monitors, Key Boards Etc.

Concrete: Clean Concrete Only, Ceramic Tiles, Asphalt, Toilets

Used Clothing: Materials, Linens Etc.

Paint: Latex & Oil Only

No Stain, Thinners, Solutions Etc.



(The Tuckerton Borough Public Works Recycling Yard is open to Borough Residents Only!)

1. Residents are required to **sign in at the office/booth** prior to discarding any materials at the Yard.
2. **Parking is limited**, so please keep moving and do not loiter.
3. All **heavy items** brought to the Yard, please notify the PW Dept. prior to Drop-off.
Arrangements can be made to drop items off at a prescribed location and loaded with Borough equipment from the ground Only!
4. For liability and safety for both our employees and customers, PW Employees are **not required** to unload materials from private vehicles.

* **Important Note:** Orange tags placed on solid waste cans throughout the Borough are an indication that your household is not recycling properly! Procedure will dictate that collection will not take place on households with recycling materials in the solid waste stream.

Steel food cans-

Appliances, auto parts, construction beams.

Aluminum cans-

New soda cans, siding for your house.

Paper-

New writing and office papers, building insulation, packaging.

Plastic bottles and milk jugs-

Plant pots, plastic lumber, can lines, lawn furniture.

Glass containers-

New glass packaging, decorative tiles, paving materials.

General Information:

Tuckerton Borough Department of Public Works Recycle Yard is open for operation *7 Days a week* from *7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.* On regularly scheduled municipally approved Holidays, the collection of solid waste and recyclables will be provided on the next regular scheduled day. An alternate collection day may be provided after a Holiday at the discretion of the Public Works Supervisor (Mr. Carl "Bobby" Hewitt).

1. All recycled materials must be properly labeled in a 35 gal. container or less not to exceed 40 lbs.
2. Recycling labels are available at the Public Works building.
3. Containers must be water tight with a lid.
4. Lids cannot be fastened to the container.


Items to be Recycled by the Borough

- Junk Mail/Mixed Paper
- Cardboard
- Co-Mingle
- Refrigerators, Freezers/Air Conditioners
 Obtain a permit from the Constr. Office - \$12.00.
 Doors must be removed from refrigerators & freezers.
- Brush & Clippings
- Telephone Books
- Miscellaneous

Aluminum and Steel/Tin Food and Beverage Cans



Paper Newspaper & Inserts, Magazines, Soft Cover & Telephone Books, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Bags, Computer, Copies, Shredded & Wrapping Paper



Hardcover Books remove cover, recycle paper
