A motion was made by Keith Vreeland and seconded by Joan Rosenberg to approve the resolution as written. On roll call vote, all eligible members voted yes. The motion was carried.

INFORMAL DISCUSSION

Mr. Mallon updated the Board regarding the subdivision initially called Yellowbrook. It will be officially filed as "Tuckerton Landings." Most of their improvements are in and they are just about ready to file a map. They did post security for that. They established their Homeowners Association and filed it with the state. They are now in the process of preparing their "Developers Agreement," an agreement between the developer and the borough. The final maps have been reviewed and finalized, with the drainage, water, sewer, and emergency access easements, plus an easement to the back of the borough's property. They will all be filed at the same time. After they get the Ocean County signature, Jack will send them to the borough. They will also have to post a Tax Map Maintenance Fee to be used next year when the Borough Engineer updates the Tax Maps. The homes are going to be built by Ryan Homes; there are 30 lots, 28 of which are buildable. Mrs. Rosenberg asked if there is a time limit for them to construct the homes. She was told there is not.

Mr. McAndrew said residents have been questioning the status of the DePalo Application. Mr. Shinn confirmed the application they submitted was deemed incomplete by Mr. Mallon; they were missing plans, surveys, signed Escrow Agreement and fees. Mr. Morey asked if there is any way of making them submit a complete application. Mr.

McAndrew said there was a court order to submit an application to this board in 90 days, which has passed. Mr. Mallon asked at what point the borough informs the judge he is not cooperating. Mr. McAndrew said he would discuss it with Phil Reed.

Mr. McAndrew congratulated our new officers, Calvin Morey, Joan Rosenberg, and Peter Gioiello and our new member, Rich Brady, and wished them all well.

ADJOURN

There being no further business, a motion was made by Jim McAndrew, seconded by Keith Vreeland and unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting.
