Daryl Mercantina, South Green Street, asked why were the special assessment letters not sent out in the summer when everyone was down at their beach homes, do we have the permits yet and why is a no return vote count as a yes vote.

Mr. Martin explained the reason for the letters was to get a feel for what residents of the beach area and paradise cove want and letters were sent to primary addresses not just the Tuckerton address.

John Zubrinkski, 707 South Green Street, thanked Councilman Vreeland for the ordinance on drainage and as for the dredging issue he feels the assessment should not be done. The actual votes that came in were a majority of No's; therefore the Council should just move on without the special assessment. Having your lagoons dredged will not increase the value of your homes so why pay additional taxes. He then asked about the lettering for the fire truck and why the Borough was having a hard time paying for that lettering; why wasn't it included in the initial cost of the truck.

Mrs. Gleghorn explained the lettering of the fire truck was paid for from the original bond ordinance done for the fire truck.

Carolyn Keen, 800 Curlew Road, thanked Mrs. Gleghorn for the time on the questions and answer session for the special assessment on dredging, she than asked if there are budget meetings this year, can they be opened to the public like they were in past years. Lastly she asked if the mobile homes located on South Green Street are individually hooked to the water and sewer system and are they billed individually.

Mrs. Gleghorn stated each pad in the mobile home park has its own water and sewer connection and they pay the same rate as everyone else in Tuckerton.

John Edmunds, Little Egg Harbor, stated he would like to thank the Chief of Police and his department for the decrease in speeders on Center Street, he is really seeing a difference.

There being no further comments or questions, Mr. Colangelo moved, second by Mr. Vreeland that the public portion of the meeting be closed. It was so moved.

Mr. Colangelo moved, second by Mr. Vreeland that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was unanimously approved at 7:52 pm.
