Mr. Colangelo moved, second by Mr. Vreeland that Resolution #152-24 be approved as read. It was so moved by the majority consent of Council. Mr. Dupuis abstained from voting.

Mr. Colangelo moved, second by Mr. Vreeland that the meeting be opened to the public.

Lee Eggert, 121 Willow Landing Terrace stated back a few months ago he asked Councilman Martin for a breakdown of what costs are charged to Water and Sewer and which ones are charged to Current account, he has not received that information yet and he would like it; he then asked how much money was stolen from the Borough by the previous Utility Collector and has the Borough received that funding back; lastly he stated the Borough has made some serious mistakes more recently with the release of a Police Officers social security number on a OPRA request that he received and hopes that Jenny handles this properly in the future.

Councilman Martin explain he will have no problem sitting down with Mr. Eggert to explain where the charges are broken up but there is not a set figure that each year it moves depending on various things, but if he would like to come sit with himself and the CFO they will explain this year's percentages.

Mr. Connors and Mrs. Gleghorn explained the Borough believes the amount missing is just under \$13,000 but they do not have the figures in front of them so they could be wrong and that as of today the Borough has not received anything back nor has the individual been before the Court system, once that happens they are sure they will have further information.

Chief Olsen stated the OPRA request mistake was on him as he was the one who ran the report, but Mrs. Gleghorn stated at the end of the day she should have reviewed it before it goes out, that is on her, she made a mistake and fixed it as soon as it was discovered.
